# **Sports in Kentucky**

#### Major College Rivalry - UofL vs UK (red/blue)

While it's an exciting time for sports in the state, it's also a time of **high tensions**, **bad-mouthing**, and **not-so-great sportsmanship**. There's typically no sense of unity. We chose the color purple to symbolize both sets of fans coming together for the betterment of our communities and in celebration of the talent we have at home.

#### No professional teams

When your dream is to go pro in Kentucky, you automatically have to associate that with eventually leaving your home and family. That can be scary for our youth. And even when the talent and skills are present, the odd's can still be blinding. Our scholarships and recruiting efforts have successfully placed students into the professional sports network and beyond.

#### "The Most Exciting Two Minutes in Sports"

Typically "most exciting" for everyone but Kentucky residents. The Derby brings an unimaginable amount of money and takes place in the middle of a community we might serve, but oftentimes overlooks, exploits, and/or ignores that same community. Most locals can't or don't participate because of cost and other factors that are meant to keep us away.

Unfortunately this can make dreams seem even more unrealistic and out-of-reach for the students we serve.

#### Goals

- Recognize the talent, progress, and achievements of young athletes, students women, and men in Kentucky
- Fundraise \$150,000 to provide post-secondary scholarships to 30 underserved students and athletes next year.
- Raise awareness of the One Plus One Mission and the unique, increasing needs of todays students and athletes
